#### REGULATION OF FUNDRAISING

- All fundraising must be submitted to the Board of Management in writing.
- All fundraising must be submitted to the principal in writing.
- All fundraising must have garda approval.
- All fundraising material (cards/sheets) must have the school stamp and the principal's signature on it.
